INTRODUCTION

PROFESSIONAL FEES

Our professional fees including access to Basic KEAP is \$30 per month per store (NMI) with annual CPI escalation to be applied on 1 January of each year, based on the previous September CPI.

Upgrade to KEAP Pro is \$10 per month per store, provided that the whole group chooses this option.

These rates exclude GST, direct costs and travelling cost outside the Melbourne Metropolitan area. Direct costs are passed on as approved and travelling time is passed on at 50% of our standard rates. Key Energy & Resources invoice quarterly against work completed. These prices assume that suitable load profile and billing data are available.
