FEATURE

Watermelons are medium in size this week, flesh may look more pink than red at the moment due to the cooler growing conditions, (flavour and quality will still be there).



Apples are now all Tasmanian supply, Royal Gala, Pink Lady, Jonagold, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, 1.5kg bags in Red, Golden and Granny Smith.



Pure Foods Eggs are finishing the "Tas Egg Co" brand in about 4 weeks, the range will be fully supported with "The Good Egg" branding lines. Egg supply will be tight on supply for the next 12 months.

NOW IN STOCK

Pink eye potatoes 15kg bags washed are now available. Other potatoes in stock are Dutch

Cream and Kennebec in 5 and 10kg bags. Washed Bintjes are available in cocktail, medium and large, Red skin washed potatoes are available in 2kg bags.

Radicchio Lettuce, Nashi Pears, Sweet Potato, Red, Gold Kiwi Fruit, 1.5kg Green Pear bags, Celeriac, Rockmelons and Honey Dew in small count sizes.

Tangellos, Cara Cara Oranges, Blood Oranges are now available (count 55 ex Griffiths NSW) and 1kg Mandarin bags are now available.

Some specialty lines available from market: Dragon fruit, Quince, Choko's, Red Papaya, Cumquats, Custard Apples, Bittermelon's, cooking Mangoes and Green Paw Paw

SWITCHING TO MAINLAND STOCK

Iceberg lettuce, all Berries (Blackberries are in short supply), Capsicum's are now mainland supply, Red, Green and Yellow. Pears Packham are now mainland (Bosc Tasmanian), Beans and Rhubarb.

- Oranges are Navel in cartons and 3kg nets
- Avocados are Hass variety (25 count trays)
- Mainland Gourmet tomatoes are medium/large size, good colour and condition
- Cherry tomatoes red are Tasmanian and Mainland
- Asparagus is imported
- Sweet Corn is from Gatton QLD
- Herbs are a mix of local and mainland
