



## Food Safety Standard 3.2.2a – Food Safety Management Tools.

## **Summary of Changes - VIC/TAS**

Vic: - changes required.

\*Food Safety Supervisor required for All Supermarkets that handle food that is unpackaged, potentially hazardous and ready-to-eat.

\*Food Safety Supervisor Certificate will now have expiry of 5 years from issue.

\*Food Safety Supervisor required for each premises from which the business operates.

\*Monitoring Records requirement remains as is.

\***Training**- Complete training and have records of training **also** must be able to demonstrate Safe Food practices if/when requested by an authorised officer (EHO).

Tas: - changes required.

\*Food Safety Supervisor required for All Supermarkets that handle food that is unpackaged, potentially hazardous and ready-to-eat.

\*Food Safety Supervisor Certificate will have an expiry of 5 years from issue. \*Food Safety Supervisor required for each premises from which the business operates.

\*Monitoring Records requirement remains as is.

\***Training** - Complete training and have records of training also must be able to demonstrate Safe Food practices if/when requested by an authorised officer (EHO).
