

# TASMANIAN Overview of Process & Announcement of State Winners

## Welcome to the 20<sup>th</sup> Year of Tasmanian IGA Awards of Excellence!

The Tasmanian IGA Awards of Excellence Program (AOE) aims to recognise and reward stores for outstanding performance and commitment to the independent retail sector.

In this document, TIR provides a detailed overview of the AOE Program and relevant judging processes, along with the announcement of the 2020 Tasmanian AOE recipients, all of whom will now be eligible to participate in the IGA National AOE Program – details of the Tasmanian AOE Recipients are noted further within.

This year, the notification process is somewhat different to prior years given the COVID-19 Pandemic and the recent social distancing restrictions in place. All Tasmanian AOE recipients have now been duly notified by TIR, with store visits to follow to arrange both the presentation of trophies to the individual store winners along with also taking some 'socially distanced' photos of the same.

TIR congratulates all Tasmanian AOE recipients for 2020, along with the wider IGA TAS Member Network, for your collective successes and the ongoing support you all provide to Tasmanian Community – well done to you all as you all winners.

### **Process Outline**

Stores are initially nominated and then judged at state level. All stores nominated for an award must meet "Overall Award Criteria" (listed below)

## **Overall National Award Criteria – Eligibility to Participate**

For a store to participate in the 2020 awards of excellence, the following criteria must be met.

- 1) The nominated store must have been trading under the Supa IGA / IGA / IGA X-Press brand for the entire required trading period (being for the **12-month period from 1st November 2018 to 31st October 2019).**
- Only stores that have achieved SILVER STATUS or above in the Operational Excellence Program (OEP) will be accepted as a nominee. Status must be achieved in the 12-month period from 1st November 2018 to 31st October 2019.
- Should the store's banner change in the nominated judging period (12-month period from 1st November 2018 to 31st October 2019), then the store must be judged under the banner it was trading as for the largest part of this period.

## **Tasmanian IGA Stores - General Information**

Tasmanian stores that have been nominated must achieve the silver status in the OEP Program and will be subject to the same checks and timelines to the mainland IGA Stores

The awards will only be judged and awarded if suitable candidates are nominated through consultation with the TIR Area Managers, (TIR AM) who must ensure that all stores meet the qualifying criteria.

The process of reviewing and assessing the nominated store/s must be consistent with AOE qualifying criteria as determined and set by Metcash, and advised to TIR.

Store and department sales are required during this process and the TIR AM will request the same from each store, however this will only occur when eligibility in the AOE process has been confirmed.

The awards categories and the store formats will be referred to throughout the document as one of the following;

- Channel 1, SUPA IGA, Large Store Format
- Channel 2, IGA, Medium Store Format,
- Channel 3, IGA Xpress, Small Store Format

Stores will be judged on the following;

#### Sales Performance (State & National)

Sales Information for all nominated awards. If the store chooses **<u>NOT</u>** to provide sales information, they will not be eligible for an award. TIR AM will request this information from Nominated Stores.

#### **Operational Excellence Program (OEP) Score (State & National)**

Scores will be sourced from the Operational Excellence Program (OEP) platform and will make up relevant department or total store scoring.

#### Open Text (Provide reason why store been nominated)

This is premised on how the store is putting the Heart & Soul back into grocery shopping and delivering our IGA Purpose & making them the "Best Store in Town", through using our 3 ingredients: all provided by the TIR AM.

- Individual Character
- Service with Soul
- Heart of the Community

#### Tasmanian Store Visits (Tasmanian Awards ONLY)

The Chairman of the TIR Board of Directors, Michael Baxter and Craig Smith, Head of Member Services will visit and separately assess / judge each store that nominated for the 2020Tasmanian AOE Program.

They will assess / judge the following areas;

- External Store Appearance
- Internal Store Appearance
- Brand Representation
- Merchandise Execution & Standards
- Team Engagement

# Scoring is based on a mixture of weighted questions that is to provide an overall result out of 100%.

## Tasmanian Store Participation in the National Awards of Excellence Program.

All Tasmanian state winners are eligible to participate in the National IGA AOE program for any given year based on the equivalent award and subsequent criteria.

The National AOE program recognises outstanding achievement across the entire IGA Network. It also recognises individual achievements in many areas throughout the IGA store base.

The assessment criteria for the National AOE Program is identical to that used by TIR locally and our winners are separately assessed by Metcash.

The winners of each National award categories are announced at the IGA National Conference & Trade Expo which is normally held on the Gold Coast in July of each year however, the 2020 event has been cancelled due to the COVID Pandemic crisis.

## **Tasmanian 2020 AOE Presentations**

Due to Covid-19 restrictions in Tasmania the presentation of the awards will take place as follows.

Executives from TIR will make contact with, and a arrange suitable time to meet with the store owner, or its nominated representatives, to facilitate the following;

- 1) Photo to be taken at store level.
- 2) Store owner or the owners nominated persons to be available at time of photo.
- 3) Tasmanian Independent Retailers Senior management will make the presentation of the winner's awards at store level at that time.
